The session provided valuable insights into effective planning for 2025. Mrs. Abisola Oshodi led discussions on the need for adaptability and agility in a dynamic global environment, emphasizing the importance of making demands from business membership organizations (BMOs) and relevant sectors. She encouraged participants to share their strategies, fostering an interactive session with active contributions and questions.

A key focus was on effective marketing strategies, where Abisola Oshodi stressed optimizing operations, enhancing customer experience, leveraging technology, and conducting regular situation analyses. She highlighted the importance of understanding market size, customer needs, and competition while maintaining strategic partnerships for long-term success.

To further strengthen businesses, She guided participants through conducting a situation analysis, stressing the need to study industry trends, competitors, and government initiatives that could provide growth opportunities. She encouraged businesses to identify their competitive edge and align strategies with emerging market trends in sectors such as health and agriculture.

Another crucial aspect covered was aligning objectives with company vision. Mrs. Abisola Oshodi advised businesses to set clear objectives, break them down into measurable goals, and prioritize them based on available resources. She emphasized the significance of a strong online presence and the strategic use of social media to reach target audiences effectively.

Financial management was also a major highlight of the session.Mrs. Abisola Oshodi underscored the importance of reviewing financial performance, budgeting, managing cash flow, and identifying funding opportunities. She advised businesses to optimize operations, minimize inefficiencies, and implement inventory control to avoid unnecessary stock accumulation.

This engaging session provided practical tools for businesses to navigate 2025 with confidence, ensuring growth, sustainability, and success.



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## **VISION BOARD 2025**

Report on Business Growth and Goal-Setting Session

This Mini workshop featured an insightful discussion led by Mrs. Oluwafeyikemi Amosu, also known as IderaConsult. She began by emphasizing the role of data in setting business goals, using the real estate business Pinky and Mj Limited as an example. She advised participants to review past performance before setting new targets and encouraged honesty in creating vision boards, viewing them as guiding tools rather than sources of pressure.

Mrs. Oluwafeyikemi Amosu shared her personal journey of adopting a healthier lifestyle through goal-setting, demonstrating how a structured vision board helped her achieve her weight loss goals. She also recounted her experience in starting a jewelry business, which initially struggled due to her lack of business knowledge. After attending an online marketing class, she gained the insights needed to grow her business successfully. This underscored the importance of setting realistic goals and taking actionable steps toward achieving them.

She further stressed the need for clarity and specificity in business goal-setting, particularly concerning income and target markets. She advised Seyi, a fashion entrepreneur, to define her audience and business impact while emphasizing the need for at least three sources of income. In response to Mojibola, an event manager struggling with financial tracking, Mrs. Oluwafeyikemi Amosu highlighted the importance of documenting income and maintaining structured financial records.

The discussion on financial stability emphasized diversifying income streams. She shared her experience of managing three businesses: Idera Jewelry for operational costs, consulting for personal projects, and a future-focused venture for long-term investments. She advised participants to explore multiple income sources to ensure financial security and freedom.

She also highlighted the significance of an online presence for business success in 2024, encouraging consistent branding and strategic social media use. She advised hiring professionals for content creation if necessary and integrating business promotions into daily interactions. Participants found her insights practical and valuable.



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## **VISION BOARD 2025**

Addressing concerns about managing multiple business responsibilities, Mrs. Oluwafeyikemi Amosu recommended documenting finances, using separate accounts, and leveraging digital tools. She emphasized goal-setting, accountability partners, and continuous learning.

The session concluded with a discussion on vision boards and personal growth.
